PAINTER'S HOUSE AWARD 2019 ARTISTIC STAYS FOR THE ACADEMY OF FINE ARTS' STIDENTS COMPETITION NOTICE AND RULES



FINALITY: The main goal is to make new generations know the southern Marche, also projecting this land's secular artistic vocation into the contemporary world. The stay will also be a stimulating opportunity of comparison and an exchange on the cultural and creative plan between the participants.

<u>PARTICIPATION</u>: Every student, signed up at Italian public and officially recognised Academy of fine arts, can participate.

STAY'S MOTHODS OF PROGRESS: Between all the received candidacies, the scientific committee will choose 16 of them. Stays will be in July and August, they'll be free for food and accommodation. The house, located at the center of Monteleone's Old Town, will receive, every two weeks, two young

artists that will create two artworks each to leave in the Municipality. Between all those artworks the scientific committee will choose the winning one.

ADMITTED TECHNIQUES: All the techniques are admitted and all the chosen materials a well.

PRIZE: The prize is € 500,00 (five hundred) and is indivisible.

EXPOSITION: every artwork will be exposed in an exhibition held in September (from 1st September 2019 to 30th September 2019) in the exhibition halls of the Town Hall. During the inauguration there'll be the awards ceremony.
